While I can appreciate the need for a permanent disposal site for this waste, I adamantly oppose using Hanford as the depository.</p> <p>As I’m sure you are aware, the DOE has been in the process of cleaning up Hanford for almost two decades and has a long way to go before that job is finished. To add more waste on top of what is</p>

I understand the proposed types of waste are currently banned from shipment to Hanford. To change this policy and import new waste of any kind will only compound the waste treatment and disposal problems, not accelerate the cleanup. Restoration of Hanford needs to be a top priority of the DOE!</p> <p>Furthermore, the risk of trucking nuclear waste on our busy highways is a recipe for disaster. A traffic accident could potentially contaminate hundreds of miles and expose countless people to this nuclear waste.</p> <p>I urge you to eliminate Hanford from your short list of sites for this waste. Let's finish the job at Hanford before adding more waste to this already compromised environmental disaster.</p>
